As always, the funds raised stay here—to allow the purchase of additional materials, supplies and furnishings that might not otherwise be possible. This year's goal is \$9,000.

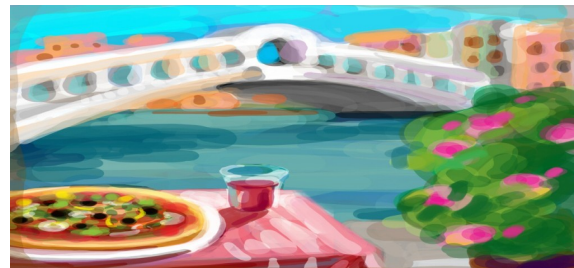
So, be sure to get your tickets before February 18th, to avoid the higher price at the door.

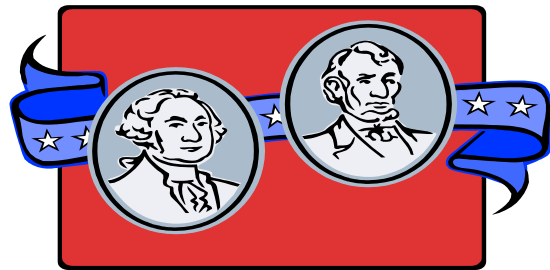

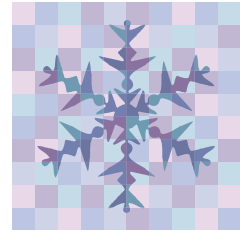

In case you wake up one morning and there is lots of snow on the ground, here is what you should do:

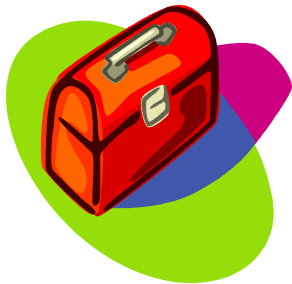
Call our number - we will change the answering machine if we are closed or opening late!
